As you may be aware, Sunnyhills School has musical instrument providers that come onto the school after hours and provide music tuition on various instruments in the Performing Arts Room. The benefits of learning a musical instrument are numerous but include:

- Studies have shown that children who are exposed to music, or those who play an instrument, do better in school than those who don't. Recent research suggests exposure to music may benefit a child's reading age, IQ and the development of certain parts of the brain.
- Improves students' time management and organizations skills.
- Teaches discipline.
- Fosters the development of team skills.
- It is fun, allows a sense of achievement and relieves stress.

An assembly on Wednesday 7th February 2018 at 11am for Kauri whanau (Years 4-6) will be a presentation from the MusiqHub tutors that work from Sunnyhills School.
