**Maritime Museum Trip**

As part of our school wide umbrella topic Manaakitanga - Caring for Others, Year 2 and 3 are about to start an Inquiry called New Zealand Heroes.

In addition to people who help in our community visiting the school to talk to us about their roles, the Year 2 and 3 classes will be visiting the Maritime Museum. While at the Museum the children will take part in a programme called 'Heroes' where they will learn about NZ heroes of the sea, such as Sir Peter Blake, America's Cup sailors, surf life savers and world beating Olympians. The children will investigate what a hero is and how they can be one too. Two classes will visit each day:

Wednesday 14 March - Rooms 15 & 16

Thursday 22 March - Rooms 14 & 22

Thursday 3 May - Rooms 21 & 24

Children will need to take a morning tea, lunch and a drink.

Transport will be by bus. We will leave school at 9.00 am and will be departing from the Maritime Museum at approximately 1 pm to return to school for the remainder of the day. We require at least one parent per trip to travel by car. Due to the nature of the trip we are unable to accommodate preschoolers. The cost of activities and bus fare for each child is \$13.00.
