Scooter Riding (Years 3 to 6)

Dear Parents / Caregivers

From Monday 19th of June students in Years 3 to 6 will be able to ride a scooter to and from school. Students will need parental permission prior to riding a scooter. Parents and Caregivers can give consent for their children to ride a scooter to school by filling in the google form on the link below.

The guidelines for this will include the following:

- The student will be riding a safety approved scooter
- No motorised / electric scooters are permitted
- The student will be wearing a safety approved helmet correctly
- The scooter and helmet will be named
- The student has a lock to secure the scooter whilst at school
- The student acknowledges that the scooter can not be ridden in the school grounds or in walkways when arriving or departing from school

Please talk to your child about being safe on their scooter.

- Give way to pedestrians
- Ride on the footpath, not the road
- Being aware of their surroundings e.g. cars turning in /out of driveways
- Riding within the limits of their ability
