Scooter Skills for Middle School

This is the rescheduled event after it was postponed last week.

Please note that some classes are now scheduled for a different day of the week from the previous notice.

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Next week, educators from Auckland Transport will come to Sunnyhills School to teach Year 3 and 4 students about safe scootering. They will run training sessions for the seven classes over two days. To maximise the learning opportunities on the day we would like students to bring a scooter and helmet from home, if available. Students will need to wear covered shoes - not sandals.

If your child has a helmet, they should bring it on the day. If your child does not have a scooter they may be able to borrow one from a friend or relative or take turns with a classmates' scooter. The educators have a small number of helmets they can loan students on the day.

What: Safe Scootering

When: Wednesday 31 May - Rooms 20, 18, 15, 19.
Thursday 1 June - Rooms 14, 16, 17

What to bring: a helmet, a scooter, wear covered shoes.
